**Conference Speakers**

**Adam W. Anz, MD** is a fellowship trained orthopedic surgeon who specializes in sports related injuries, specifically focusing on complex knee surgery, hip arthroscopy, and innovative biologic treatments, with a special interest in stem cells for cartilage regeneration. His main goal is to keep patients of all ages as active as possible in the least invasive way.



Dr. Anz attended the University of South Alabama College of Medicine. He completed his orthopedic surgery residency training at Wake Forest University in Winston-Salem. Following his residency, Dr. Anz completed a sports fellowship at the Steadman Clinic in Vail, Colorado.

Dr. Anz has contributed and appeared in many peer-reviewed publications and presentations. His strongest research interest is in cartilage regeneration.

Dr. Anz is a candidate member of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons, the Arthroscopy Association of North America, and the American Orthopaedic Society for Sports Medicine.

**Paul Lafferty, MD** is Assistant Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery at the University of Minnesota. He is board certified in orthopaedic surgery and specializes in Orthopaedic Trauma at Regions Hospital in Saint Paul, MN. He has authored or coauthored numerous manuscripts published in peer-reviewed journals and multiple book chapters. His work has been presented at local, regional, and national meetings and he speaks locally and regionally on Orthopaedic Trauma.
