# **Conference Speakers**



Vijaya Gottumukkala, MB, BS, MD, FRCA, received postgraduate training in Anesthesiology and Critical Care from All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi India and was a Fellow of the Royal College of Anesthetists, in London.
