Conference Speakers



Vijaya Gottumukkala, MB, BS, MD, FRCA, received postgraduate training in Anesthesiology and Critical Care from All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi India and was a Fellow of the Royal College of Anesthetists, in London. He spent residency training at the University of Iowa, Iowa City, IA. Dr. Gottumukkala is now a professor, and Deputy Chairman and Clinical Director of the

Department of Anesthesiology and Perioperative Medicine at the University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston, TX. His research focuses on cancer: enhanced recovery protocols in major cancer surgery; perioperative management on recurrence free and overall survival in patients with cancer; and educational programs relevant to perioperative care of the cancer patient.



Vijay Gaba, MD, is an anesthesiologist and is affiliated with the Sanford Health System in Fargo, ND. He also serves as Assistant Professor of Surgery at the UND School of Medicine and Health Sciences in Grand Forks. In addition, Gaba is the NDSA Director to the ASA Board of Directors since 2013. He received his medical degree from Delhi University College of Medical Sciences and completed a residency in

Anesthesiology at St. Vincent's Hospital in Manhattan, NY. In addition, Dr. Gaba holds a certification in Pediatric Anesthesiology. In 2008, Dr. Gaba developed a protocol for anesthesia management of pediatric patients with upper respiratory tract infection (URI) undergoing surgery.



Randolph E. Szlabick, MD, FACS, is the Associate Professor of Surgery at the UND School of Medicine & Health Sciences in Grand Forks. He was Associate Program Director of Surgery at UND from September 1, 2008-June 30, 2017. He received his MD from Wayne State School of Medicine and completed his general surgery residency at the William Beaumont Hospital in Royal Oak, Michigan. Dr. Szlabick is

board certified in general surgery and in surgical critical care.



Kevin Mork, MD, is an anesthesiologist affiliated with Altru Hospital in Grand Forks. He received his medical degree at the UND School of Medicine in Grand Forks and a BS in Bacteriology at the North Dakota State University in Fargo. Dr. Mork completed his anesthesiology residency at Walter Reed Army Medical Center, Washington DC. In addition, Dr. Mork is a Clinical Assistant Professor of Surgery at the UND School of Medicine and Health

Sciences in Grand Forks.
